Since it is a research workshop, TSWIM also actively solicits innovative and thought-provoking papers describing novel research ideas that may be at a relatively early stage of development (research-in-progress submissions) to improve its future publication possibility. We encourage IS PhD students to submit their thesis-in-progress work to TSWIM. International IS scholars will be invited as discussants to provide comments for paper presentations.
